

How the word *tempt* is used

I Tempt (peirasmos) – a putting to proof, solicitation, discipline or provocation

From (peirazo) – to test, i.e. endeavor, scrutinize, entice, discipline

From (peira) – (through the idea of piercing); a test, i.e. attempt, experience

From (peran) – (to pierce)

II Tempt (dokimos)- acceptable, (current after assay) i.e. approved

From (dokeo) to think, to seem truthful

From (deiknuo) to show

God does not tempt any one to sin

How did Jesus overcome temptation??

- Matt 4:1-11 Led by the Spirit into dessert
- Heb 2:5-8 Man a little lower than angels
- Heb 2:9-18 Jesus a little lower than angels
Made like brethren
- Heb 4:14-16 Tempted as we are

We are tested by God and tempted by Satan

James 1:12-18	Led by own desires
Matt 26:36-46	Watch and pray
Mark 14:32-42	Flesh is weak spirit willing
I Cor 10:13	God provides a way of escape

We overcome Satan just as Jesus did with a self
sacrificial attitude of submission to Him
