

How does God view sin?

Gen 2:17	Transgression of will = death
I John 3:4	Sin is lawlessness
Rom 5:13, 7:7	Sin is not imputed where no law
Lev 5:1-19	Unintentional, Ignorant
Lev 6:1-7	Intentional
Nu 15:22-29	Unintentional assembly-individual
Nu 15:30-31	Presumptuous
I Jn 5:14-17	Some sins to death some not
Jude 22-23	Make a distinction

We must learn about sin and how Satan uses it against us

The first sin a person is guilty of will violate the conscience

Gen 3:6-8 Eyes open, ashamed, hid from God

I Peter 3:21 Baptism – answer of a good conscience

Heb 10:19-25 Heart sprinkled from an evil conscience

Obedience must be provoked from God – obedience is to God not the preacher

The nature and characteristic Satan's influence is deceitful

I Kings 13:1-32 "Man of God" was lied to by another prophet

I Kings 22:1-28 Micaiah against 400 false prophets

II Peter 2:1-22 Satan *distorts* what is good

1. Contentment – Covetousness (3,4)
2. Fill our role – Despise authority (10)
3. Self esteem – Presumptuous/Pride (10)
4. Satisfy feelings – Lusts of flesh (10, 18)
5. Have freedom – Liberty w/o limits (19)

Through the (lust) of the flesh, (lust) of the eyes and pride of life Satan catches the unsuspecting

Do we have what it takes to deal with sin

Jude 24-25	To Him who is able
Rom 5:12-21	Grace might reign
II Peter 2:9	Lord knows how to deliver
I Cor 10:13	God is faithful
II Tim 2:15	Be diligent

Through Christ we do have what it takes to overcome Satan (I Cor 15:57)
